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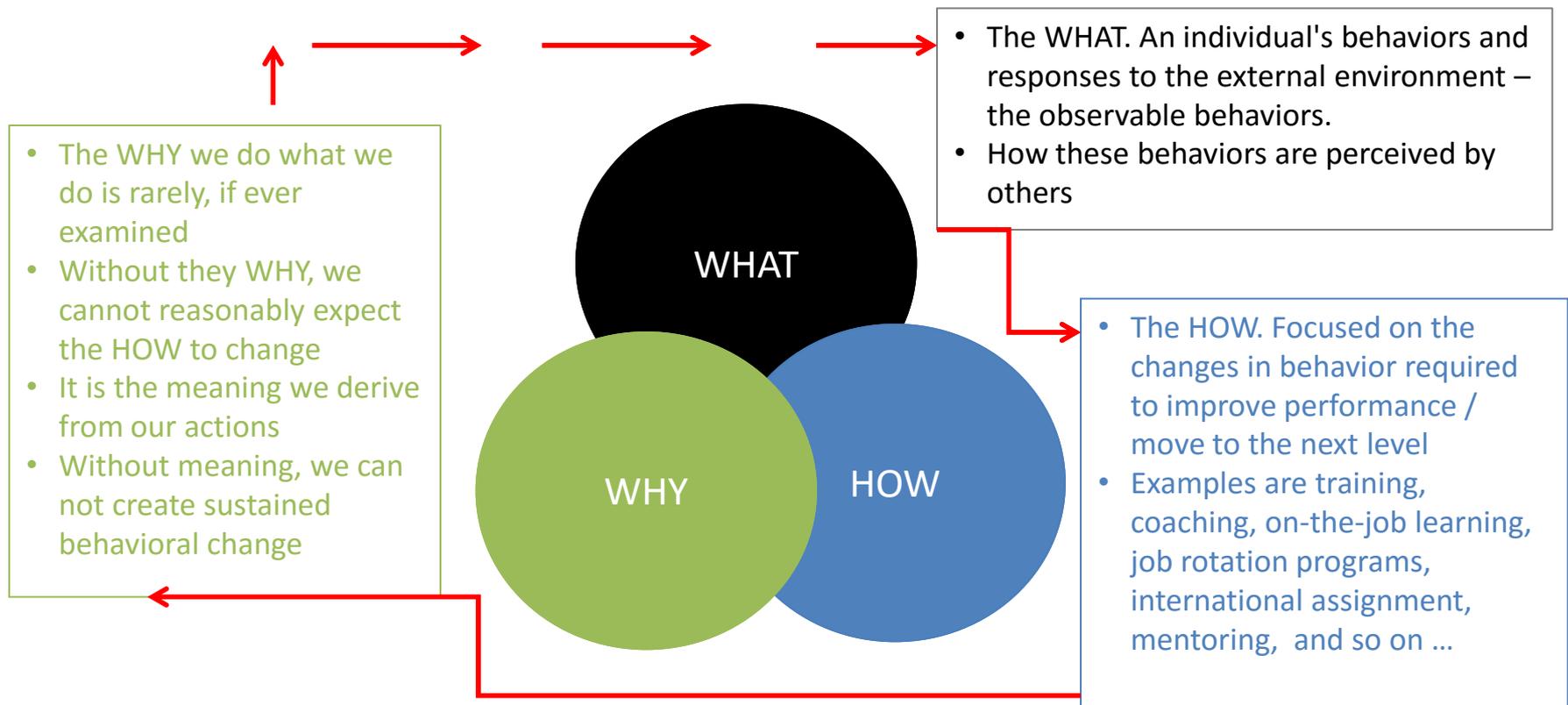

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Personal Leadership Development Framework

The ultimate objective of a personal leadership development program is to improve individual performance

- To do this requires an understanding of three core elements



How to look at yourSelf

- Hierarchy – in my family

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- Attachment – emotional patterns

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- **I**dentity – who I know I am
- **E**motions - 8 basic / my dominant

Strategic SWOT

A Strategic SWOT analysis can produce issues which very readily translate into one of four categories of strategic action. A Strategic SWOT takes the completed SWOT analysis and uses it as the basis to define a “To Be” state. This second stage in using SWOT centres on the question 'what shall we do' about the issues in each of these categories? Again an organisation simply follows the headings and plots its Offensive, Development, Re-positioning and Defensive strategies.

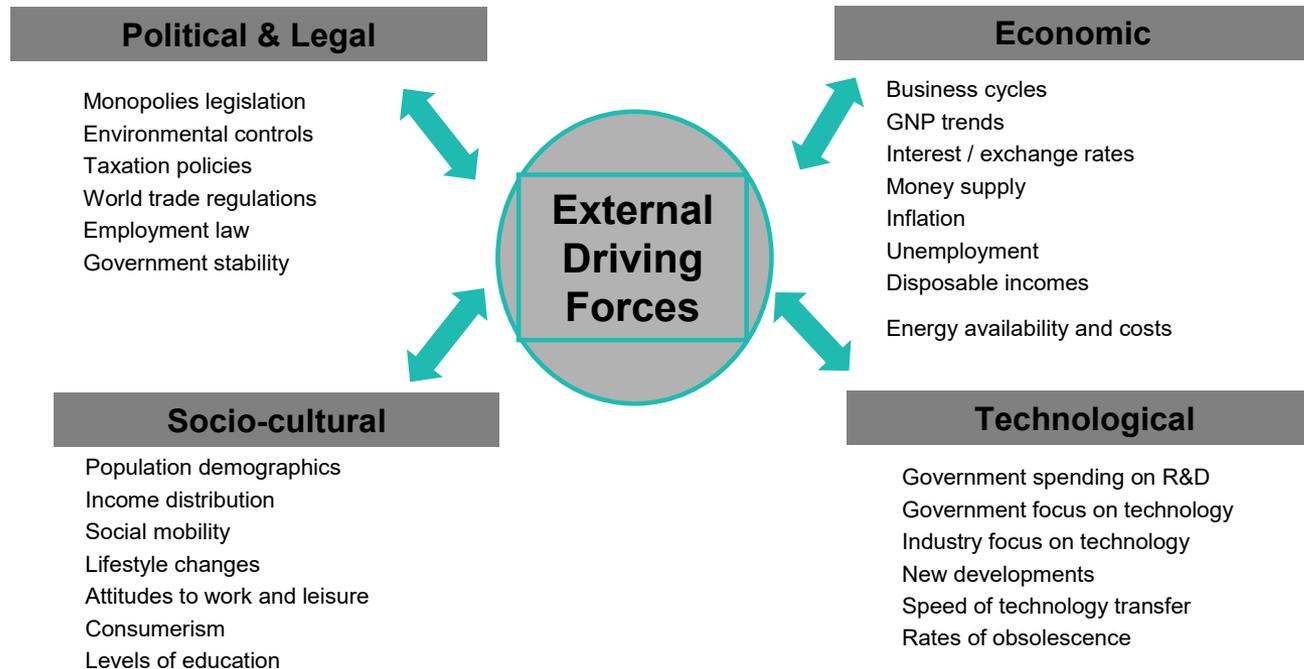
The SWOT analysis headings provide a good framework for reviewing **strategy**, **position** and **direction** of a company or business proposition.

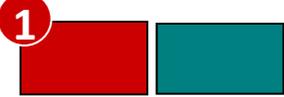

PEST Analysis

PEST Analysis is a strategy framework used to scan the external macro environment in which an organisation operates. PEST factors are usually beyond the control of the organisation and are considered either threats or opportunities. Sometimes extended forms of analysis are used such as STEEPLE: Social/Demographic, Technological, Economic, Environmental (natural), Political, Legal and Ethical factors.

Completing a PEST analysis is relatively simple and can be done in workshops using brainstorming techniques.





De Bono Visioning (6 Thinking Hats)

This tool helps individuals deliberately adopt a variety of perspectives that may be different to the ones they would naturally assume. It can be used for exploring different perspectives within a situation or challenge. Individuals simply “put on” a different hat and then consciously adopt that perspective for a time.

The white hat	Neutral, logical, information-based, factual	White	Let's have the facts; neutral and objective What do we actually know to be a fact? Is it a fact or a likelihood, or a belief?
The red hat	Intuitive, feelings-based, no explanation needed	Red	The opposite of neutral objectivity Hunches, intuitions, impressions - don't justify Reacting and getting upset!
The black hat	Logical, negative, cautious, risk-averse	Black	Logical-negative; why it won't work It doesn't fit our knowledge and experience Devil's advocate; what about the risks?
The yellow hat	Logical, positive, benefit-seeking	Yellow	Positive; optimistic; focus on benefits Constructive thinking; making things happen Speculative, seeking opportunities; visionary
The green hat	Creative, out-of-the-box, imaginative, unconstrained	Green	New ideas, concepts, perceptions and approaches Alternatives and more alternatives; change Lateral thinking; creativity; random provocation
The blue hat	Overview, process control, agenda-creating, decision-seeking	Blue	Thinking about thinking; organisation; control Define the problem; ask the right question Observation; overview; summaries; conclusions
